


**Montour Junction Wye 2 - 67' Spans Deck Plate Girder Concrete deck

This satellite view shows the bridge in lower center crossing Montour Run. Wye track right-of-way is evident curving up and to right. Rt. 51 runs along left edge of picture, P&LE (now CSX) tracks across upper right. Montour Shops foundations are at top center.




A similar view from 1973 shows the shops and yard tracks in place. Railroad activity abounds as the car shop in upper left is full of hoppers under repair and rebuild, while the yard tracks along the left side are full of empty hoppers waiting to be taken to the coal mines. On the track leading into the shops, several locomotives await their next assignment.
